Started in 1986 by Sarah Ann Bowers it is one of her proudest accomplishments. Ms. Bowers wanted to improve the beautiful Cordell Hull Highway and needed to prove that this road was very well traveled. Therefore, in 1986 she put a yard sale on the Cordell Hull Highway and in 2001, over 140,000 visitors traveled to the Rollercoaster Sale! After 10 years the attendance surpassed that of the Kentucky Derby.

Today Hwy. 63, a Kentucky Scenic Byway, is a road well traveled and has been greatly improved, due to Ms. Bowers persistent efforts. She also was instrumental in bringing the Rollercoaster Yard Sale into Tennessee in 2002 — from Hwy. 63 through Clay County & Celina, Overton County & Livingston, and through Pickett County & Byrdstown. Now the Rollercoaster route has been extended to go completely around Dale Hollow Lake picking up at Hwy. 127 at the Tennessee and Kentucky state line in Static — and then north on Hwy. 127 through Clinton County & Albany, then turn west on Hwy. 90 to Cumberland County & Burkesville, continue north on Hwy. 90 back to Glasgow & Cave City, Kentucky.
